Dear Mr. Orr:

This is in reference to your request on behalf of the City of West Memphis for an approved jurisdictional determination (AJD) on Ditches 1, 2, 5, 6 and Wetland 1 on property located north and west of the City of West Memphis, Crittenden County, Arkansas, as shown on the enclosed maps. Based on the information you provided, a site visit, and other information available to us, it is our AJD that Ditches 1, 2, 5, 6 and Wetland 1 are not considered waters of the United States. Therefore, no Department of the Army permit is required under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act to place fill into these areas.

This letter contains an AJD for your subject site. If you object to this determination, you may request an administrative appeal under Corps of Engineers regulations at 33 CFR Part 331. Enclosed you will find a Notification of Appeal Process and Process and Request for Appeal (RFA) form. If you request to appeal this determination you must submit a completed RFA form to the Mississippi Valley Division at the following address:

In order for an RFA to be accepted by the Corps of Engineers, the Corps of Engineers must determine that it is complete, that it meets the criteria for appeal under 33 CFR Part 331.5 and that is has been received by the division office within 60 days of the date of the RFA. Should you decide to submit an RFA form, it must be received at the above address by March 6, 2021. It is not necessary to submit an RFA form to the division office if you do not object to the determination in this letter.

This determination has been conducted to identify the limits of the Corps of Engineers Clean Water Act jurisdiction for the particular site identified in this request. This determination may not be valid for the wetland conservation provisions of the Food Security Act of 1985. If you or your tenant are United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) program participants, or anticipate participation in the USDA program, you should request a certified wetland determination from the local office of the Natural Resources Conservation Service, prior to starting work.
